Meditation: *“For he is our peace; in his flesh he has made both groups into one and has broken down the dividing wall, that is, the hostility between us. He has abolished the law with its commandments and ordinances, that he might create in himself one new humanity in place of the two, thus making peace, and might reconcile both groups to God in one body through the cross, thus putting to death that hostility through it.”*

Reflection: God has always had in mind His children, being one in family, living in peace and perfect in love. This is a completed work in God's economy, but hard to live here and now. Worship breaks down gates and walls, freeing us to become part of God's dream.
