Meditation: *“I pray that you may have the power to comprehend, with all the saints, what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, so that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.”*

Reflection: Paul's asking that our comprehension of God living in us, and to “all the fullness of God” is a startling statement; one that we might retreat from as being impossible. After all, we are guilty of wrong doing. Our conscience is more at peace with this idea, when we are connected to God, endeavoring with Him in our physical bodies, rather than living however we want, while separating our spiritual life to a private conversation with God only, to the neglect of living Christ publicly.

Your Action: Where do you find yourself asking the question, “Don't all those who do wrong know?” In what ways can you demonstrate a critique of the systems that oppress those far off? Where do you look for solitude and safety when things are difficult, and how do you reconcile wrong doing and public reflection of Jesus?
