Meditation: “Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.” Also; “It is written in the prophets, ‘And they shall all be taught by God.’ Everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to me... Very truly, I tell you, whoever believes has eternal life. I am the bread of life.”

Reflection: *In Solomon’s prayer, we find a fresh start is always possible with a willing heart. Jesus calls us to be fed by the bread of life, transforming ourselves to transform the world.*
