Meditation: “...You said, 'My name shall be there,.. Hear the plea of your servant and of your people Israel when they pray toward this place; ... Likewise when a foreigner, who is not of your people Israel, comes from a distant land because of your name, for they shall hear of your great name, your mighty hand, and your outstretched arm--when a foreigner comes and prays toward this house, then hear in heaven your dwelling place,..”



Reflection: Solomon's temple is a symbol not only of his accomplishments as king but also of a hope for harmony in all creation. Jesus tells us that this hope is fulfilled only through his body.

All systems and structures, however benign, will seek to usurp the place of the spirit that gives life.
