Meditation: *Jesus said to them, “...Listen to me, all of you, and understand: there is nothing outside a person that by going in can defile, but the things that come out are what defile. For it is from within, from the human heart, that evil intentions come.”*



Reflection: God's saving justice is marked by simplicity of faith and expressed by helping widows and orphans in their hardships and keeping oneself uncontaminated by the world (James 1:27).

The word for world here is better translated as "systems," the powers and principalities (Ephesians 6:12) that impede both the saving justice of God and the springtime of hope, poetically described in Song of Songs as an awakening of love. May our prayer and our desire be that the seasons of glad songs will come (Song of Songs 2:12).

Your Action: What are you doing to welcome the seasons of glad songs?
