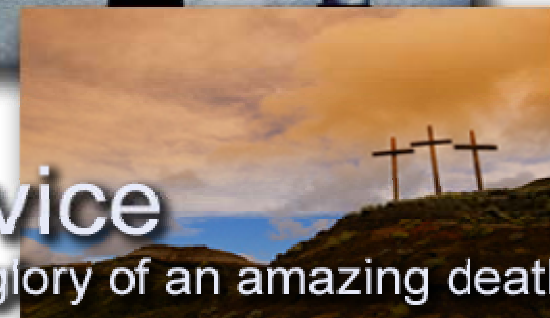

church discussion...

Meditation: *"Can you drink the cup that I shall drink, or be baptized with the baptism with which I shall be baptized?" (Mark 10:38)*

Reflection: Most of us do not naturally contemplate God. Like the disciples we tend to offer the kind of prayers that ask God "to do us a favor" (Mark 10:35). Status and influence are more to us than spirituality. We find it hard to hear the question that that Jesus asks, which is true holiness. Serving God demands the same generosity of spirit with which God serves us. When we are obedient to God's calling we learn, like Jesus, through suffering (Hebrews 5:8). The reward is service, and to share with Jesus "the source of eternal salvation" (5:9).
