Meditation: *Jesus said to his disciples, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the treasury. For all of them have contributed out of their abundance; but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, all she had to live on." Mk12.43-44*

Reflection: Widows frequently appear in both Old and New Testament readings as a symbol of society's most vulnerable members, who are worthy of special care according to Israelite religious law. Jesus notes the example of a widow and contrasts her with church leaders whose superficial piety does not disguise their quest for power and acclaim at the expense of the poor. The poor widow, gives not of her excess but "out of her poverty" (Mk 12.43-44).

As we approach the end of the liturgical year and prepare for the birth of God among us, we are reminded that *what* we give, of ourselves and our possessions, is of little importance. Instead, *how* we give to others is what will show the world that God is among us.
