[Think & Pray...]

**Meditation:** “You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come? Bear fruits worthy of repentance. Do not begin to say to yourselves, ‘We have Abraham as our ancestor’;... So, with many other exhortations, he proclaimed the good news to the people. lk. 3.7b-8a, & 18

**Reflection:** Repentance is not just saying you're sorry, nor is it merely a change in your head or even your heart. Gospel repentance involves a change in your behavior, in the way you live your life. Most people likely see John's call to a transformed life as an indictment, and his mandate for treating the poor justly as, at best, an unpleasant chore. But John's call to repentance should be seen for what it is: **an invitation to salvation**, the fruit of relationship with the Holy One coming into our midst. When we respond to this invitation in a joyful spirit, we may help to contribute not only to a transformed world but to our own liberation.

**Consider:** Have we missed our own liberation? Discuss your/our common gift of salvation. How do you view it; as a past event; a future event; or a communal witness, that transcends time and space. Do you see grace at its center, freeing us from works, false piety, and guiding us toward JOY and a fulfilling journey in community? And again, might this still be the calling of god's prophetic voice through His people today to a weary world? Is there still JOY in this GOOD NEWS?
