Meditation: “ Jesus took with him Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly they saw two men, Moses and Elijah, talking to him. They appeared in glory and were speaking of his departure, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. ” (Lk 9 .28b-31)

Reflection: “We do not have many functional Christian communities which can walk the journey with us and help us discern between darkness and light, our shadow and our true selves in Christ. We need relationships of duration and truth 'to unveil our faces so that we can reflect like mirrors the brightness of the Lord.' In Christian community we will 'all grow brighter and brighter as we are gradually turned into the image that we reflect; this is the work of the Lord who is Spirit' (2 Corinthians 3:18). - Richard Rohr, OFM, **To Unveil Our Faces**
