**Meditation:** “ Jesus said to them again, “Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.” When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit.”

(John 20 .21-22)

**Reflection:** The disciples have heard from Mary and the other women that Jesus has risen, but they are still very much afraid, hidden away in their fear behind closed doors. Their movement, it seemed, was an abject failure, their hopes crucified with their leader.

Then, to their great surprise, if not shock, Jesus is there among them.

This gathering is like a mini-Pentecost: the disciples covered in a locked room, and Jesus breathes on them, filling them with life and the Holy Spirit.
